EXPECTATIONS OF PARENTS of STUDENTS WHO PARTICIPATE IN SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

(Expectations noted below are from the Supplemental Educational Services Toolkit for Nebraska Schools, Districts, and Providers – provided by the Nebraska Department of Education's NCLB, Title I Office)

- Parents will return the Provider Selection Form to begin the services process for their child.
- Parents will meet with the Provider and the school representative to write and sign the Individual Learning Plan.
- Parents will ensure that their child receives the services by monitoring their child's attendance and progress.
- Parents will communicate regularly with the Provider, especially to notify the provider in advance if the child is to be absent.
- Parents will inform the provider and the school if their child no longer intends to participate.
- Parents will meet with the Provider and the school representative to receive the information and sign the summary report at the end of the program.
- Parents will complete an evaluation of the SES services received. A form will be provided by NDE, at the end of the school year

In addition to the above expectations, please note that the following are also responsibilities of the parent:

- Provide transportation to and from wherever the provider will be rendering the services
- Provide a computer and access to the internet if services are to be delivered on-line
- Provide appropriate level of supervision for your child during provider services
