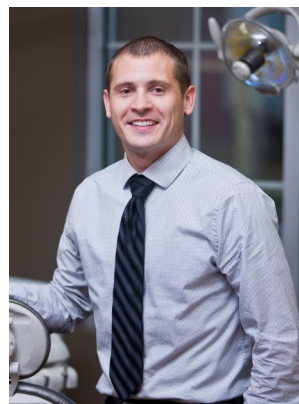

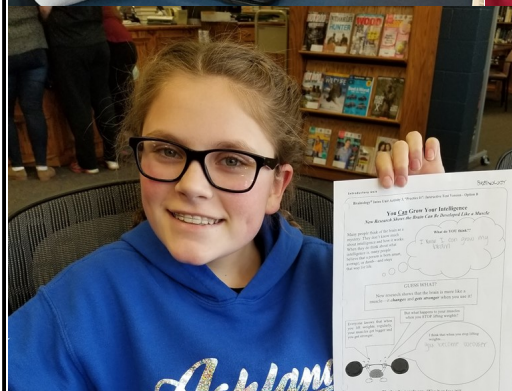
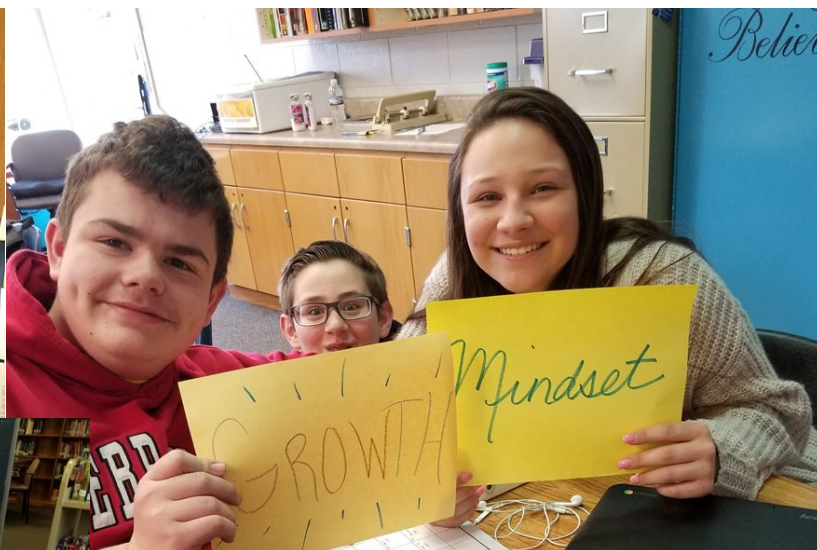

Teacher Grant Programs for 2018-2019

HELPING KIDS FOCUS (STANDING DESKS)

Impacts 25-30 Middle school students

Total cost: \$750 (\$375 will be supported through the Foundation and \$375 will be supported through the school)

The helping kids focus project will help students grasp more information in the classroom as well as help them apply and retain that information. The desks will be divided among the middle school classrooms and will be used by students whose attention is improved when they are allowed to stand up rather than sit in a desk.

THE WHIZ-BANG SUPER SCIENCE SHOW - OMAHA CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

Impacts approximately 425 students Grades PK-5

Total cost: \$478

In the two 45 minute Science shows, the students will encounter and H2O rocket blasting through the air using an Airzooka, electrical sparks from a generator, and a 2-liter bottle of soda erupting 10 feet in the air! The museum presenter will make science exciting as students explore air pressure, electricity, and chemistry through whole group experiments!

DUAL CREDIT OPPORTUNITIES

Impacts approximately 10 High School students

Total cost: \$1750 (10 College classes at \$175 each)

Research shows that if a student leaves high school with at least 15 hours of college credit they are more likely to be successful in a college setting. This grant will allow students who are unable to afford the tuition to take classes and ultimately the opportunity to excel!!

Teacher Grant Programs for 2018-2019

IXL MATH AND IXL ELA EDUCATIONAL SOFTWARE

Impacts approximately 150 students Grades 4-5

Total cost: \$2700 (\$1350 will be supported through the Foundation and \$1350 will be supported through the school)

IXL Math and IXL ELA will help students practice and master skills as defined by the College and Career ready standards. The program is adaptive and works well with the schools' blended learning teaching methods, so each student receives the practice he/she needs. Effective implementation will result in more individualized practice and instruction and increased student learning as well as higher average score on standardized tests.

MUSIC CLASS UKULELES

Impacts all 6th grade students

Total cost: \$800

For several years, students have asked about learning piano, guitar, or ukuleles as part of music class. Ukuleles are instruments that are growing in popularity due to their size, ease of learning, and cost. This grant will allow students to learn an instrument while reinforcing elements of music, reading, math, and science as the instrument is studied.

ROSE THEATER EDUCATIONAL TOURING PROGRAMS

Impacts all elementary school students

Total cost: \$450

The Rose Theater will put on a production for Pre-K to 2nd grade students called "Music Makers", that include themes of loneliness, friendship, and collaboration in an interactive show. For the students in grades 3-5, the production will be "The Bully Show", where students will learn what a bully is and ways to deal with one. It also explains how the school is a safe place and how to make it that way. The play will make students aware of how bullying is not an acceptable behavior.

BRING THE ZOO TO YOU

Impacts all Pre-K students and their families

Total cost: \$300

Bring the Zoo to You is an educational and fun program which provides participants with live animal encounters, interactions with artifacts, and the opportunity to participate in hands-on games and activities. This opportunity will be combined with the pre-school program quarterly Parent Advisory Meeting. Students and Parents alike will be excited to participate in this irresistible opportunity!!

Teacher Grant Programs for 2018-2019

FULL STEAM AHEAD

Impacts approximately 20 students in the AG Middle School Science Club

Total cost: \$1430

A club type program will engage students in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics) activities. This grant will help provide access to technology and experiences that will enrich students to fully develop their potential by providing the opportunities to experience STEAM inquiry-based, hands-on learning. By better preparing and arming our students with the proper resources, devices, and tools, this grant will help them excel in any STEAM career that they may choose. Students will build and share their project with the club using teamwork, communication skills, and planning/organizational skills. Instructors will arrange speakers, activities, and field trips that will help build members' knowledge of their passion!

MINDFULNESS TRAINING AND INTERVENTION GROUP

Impacts all elementary school students

Total cost: \$1950

Mindfulness is the awareness of thoughts, emotions, sensations, and the surrounding environment. Several studies have shown that developing mindfulness can benefit students by reducing stress, managing stress, decreasing anxiety, improving attention span and focus, increase self-control, self-awareness and self-regulation, improve executive functioning skills, decrease test anxiety, and improve ADHD symptoms. This grant will allow members of the Student Assistance Team (SAT) to attend a Mindfulness training in the area and then have the opportunity to come back to the school district and teach staff members about the importance and implementation of Mindfulness techniques. They would then develop groups who need extra support in the area of mindfulness and work on these activities at weekly meetings.
